

Gender, Pregnancy and Radiotherapy

'This procedure/treatment uses ionising radiation, which could be harmful to a pregnancy'.

NHS Fife collects information on patients in order to improve services and monitor use of services. Some of this information will be gathered for a national purpose and some for local purposes.

We may not know if your gender is different than that at birth.

But you may want to tell us.

We will ask you if you are pregnant.

You may not know or want to say however the procedure may seriously affect your pregnancy.

We will not disclose any information in relation to your transgender status unless you say so.

We ask these questions in order to make sure you are fully informed of the intervention and that you know and understand the risks.
